



Cub Scout World Conservation Award

The Cub Scout version of the World Conservation Award can be earned by Wolf or Bear Cub Scouts, and by Webelos Scouts. This award can be earned only once while you are in Cub Scouting (i.e. as either a Wolf Cub Scout, a Bear Cub Scout, or as a Webelos Scout). The World Conservation Award is worn on the uniform shirt, centered on the right pocket as a TEMPORARY patch.

As a **Wolf Cub Scout**, you can earn the Cub Scout World Conservation Award by doing the following:

1. Complete achievement [#7 - Your Living World](#)
2. Complete all Arrow Points in 2 of the following 3 Electives:
 - o [#13 - Birds](#)
 - o [#15 - Grow Something](#)
 - o [#19 - Fishing](#)
3. Participate in a den or pack conservation project in addition to the above

As a **Bear Cub Scout**, you can earn the Cub Scout World Conservation Award by doing the following:

1. Complete achievement [#5 - SHARING YOUR WORLD WITH WILDLIFE](#)
2. Complete all requirements in 2 of the following 3 electives:
 - o [#2 - Weather](#)
 - o [#12 - Nature Crafts](#)
 - o [#15 - Water and Soil Conservation](#)
3. Participate in a den or pack conservation project in addition to the above

As a **Webelos Scout**, you can earn the Cub Scout World Conservation Award by doing the following:

2. Earn the [Naturalist activity badge](#).
3. Earn the [Outdoorsman activity badge](#).
